Top Team Building Locations in Calgary

#1. Downtown Calgary

Recommended Activity: The Amazing Chase

Calgary has one of the densest and most exciting downtown areas for a city of its size, in all of North America. There's everything from the Olympic Plaza, to the famous elevated walkways, and the Calgary Tower. Your team can see it all with an activity like The Amazing Chase, where they'll complete racestyle challenges - just like they're on the TV show!



Recommended Activity: Cardboard Boat Building Challenge

Sandy Beach Park is a great local spot on the west side of Calgary. The park is 33 hectares, and includes lots of space for corporate events, company picnics, and BBQs. It's a perfect location for an activity like Cardboard Boat Building Challenge, because your group can test out their vessels in the waters of the Elbow River.



Recommended Activity: Corporate Castaways

What better place to experience a team building activity inspired by the TV show "Survivor" than the only island in Calgary? Imagine your team marooned on Prince's Island Park, and competing in a series of challenges to outwit, outplay, and outlast. The picnic areas and surrounding hiking trails are the perfect setting for this team building activity.

#4. Stampede Park

Recommended Activity: CI: The Crime Investigators

One of the biggest event centres in Calgary, Stampede Park has a variety of versatile and unique spaces for corporate events.Here, your team could try to solve a rodeo mystery for the Calgary Police,and investigate a series of simulated crime scenes.

Top Scavenger Hunt Locationsin Calgary

Scavenger hunts are a hugely popular activity for corporate groups visiting Calgary. Teams can use their smartphones to complete challenges all around the city.

#1. Downtown Calgary

Recommended Scavenger Hunt: Wild Goose Chase

A scavenger hunt through downtown Calgary will give your team the chance to explore some of the city's top landmarks. From the Calgary Tower, to City Hall, to the famous Stephen Avenue Walk – the downtown is a great spot to go on a Wild Goose Chase.

#2. Beltline

Recommended Scavenger Hunt: Random Acts Of Kindness

Just south of downtown is the Beltline, one of the busiest areas of Calgary. In this neighbourhood, you'll find a ton of bars, restaurants, and shops – as well as the Stampede Grounds, and Central Memorial Park. It's the perfect location for Random Acts Of Kindness, where your team will be challenged to perform good deeds for strangers in the area.

#3. East Village

Recommended Scavenger Hunt: Urban Fear Factor

East Village was Calgary's first neighbourhood, which makes it a fun location for your Urban Fear Factor scavenger hunt. Get your team out of their comfort zones with challenges along the RiverWalk, the Crossroads Plaza, and Celebration Square.

#4.Eau Claire

Recommended Scavenger Hunt: Play It Forward

North of downtown is the neighbourhood of Eau Claire, which has a mix of urban and natural settings for your group to explore. Here, your team can try a charitable scavenger hunt, like Play It Forward, and give back to Calgarians around Prince's Island Park, the Eau Claire Market, and other community hotspots.

Top Indoor Team Building Venues in Calgary

#1. Genesis Centre

Recommended Activity: The Apprentice

The Genesis Centre includes a built-in stage, catering kitchen, sound system, and reception area. It would be an ideal location for The Apprentice, where teams build bicycles for children in need. Teams would be able to finish the activity in an exciting way - by presenting their finished bicycles on stage, in front of your entire group!



Recommended Activity: Minute To Win It

Marquee is a dual concept location. It combines the comforts of a hip craft beer house with a state-of-the-art live music venue. With over 13,000 square feet, cool rock era décor and ample free venue parking, Marquee provides a great atmosphere for an energetic team building activity, such as Minute To Win It.

#3. Sirocco Golf Club

Recommended Activity: Team Pursuit
